### **AWARDS**

For over sixty years the Romantic Novelists' Association has recognised, celebrated and awarded excellence in romantic fiction. The Romantic Novel Awards are presented each year and honour the best in romantic fiction across multiple sub-genres, including Contemporary Romance, Historical Romance, Romantic Comedy and Fantasy Romantic Fiction. The awards are judged by a panel of romantic fiction readers.



### **JOAN HESSAYON AWARD**

Authors who become published after graduating from the New Writers' Scheme may be eligible to be entered into the Joan Hessayon Award. This award honours debut authors and celebrates the achievement of getting published.



### THE RNA INDUSTRY AWARDS

These awards are highly respected in the UK publishing industry and provide an opportunity for the RNA to recognise and thank the many professionals who work to promote the genre of romantic fiction and support our organisation. The winners are nominated by members of the RNA and the awards are presented in November at the winter party.
